MEET THE CHAIRMAN



Jeff Michael, the President at North Point Chrysler Jeep Dodge Ram FIAT, was elected Chairman of the North Carolina Automobile Dealers Association (NCADA) at the group's annual family convention at the Greenbrier Resort in White Sulphur Springs, West Virginia in June.

Prior to being the Chairman of NCADA, Jeff Michael was the Vice-Chairman, serving for the 2020-2021 term. Jeff got into the car business full-time in November 1985 at Parkway Ford. Starting as a salesperson, Jeff worked his way up to F&I, then to New Car Manager, and finally to General Sales Manager. It was in November of 1997, that Jeff took over Bob Neill Chrysler Plymouth Jeep Eagle, as the company's general manager. Within just 6 months he was named President of the dealership, now renamed North Point Chrysler Jeep Inc. In November 2008, his company bought Triad Dodge in Winston Salem and merged it with the North Point dealership. In 2011, he opened Alfa Romeo of Greensboro.

Jeff has served on numerous boards including NCADA's Dealers Choice from 2004–2018 where he was the chairman from 2014–2016. He has also served on the Regional and National Dealer Council (FCA) for 8 years. An active member in the Winston–Salem community, Jeff has supported the Little League of Forsyth County, Forsyth County Human Society, Winston–Salem Street School, YMCA, United Way, and many more local schools, churches, and organizations.
