From the countless charitable activities of individual dealers throughout North Carolina to our NCADA Hometown Heroes program, our industry truly gives back to our fellow citizens. But our contributions go way beyond our charitable efforts. Franchised dealers are a crucial part of our local, state, and national economies. NADA's final economic impact data for 2023 was recently released and here are just a few of the key numbers:



- Franchised dealerships were responsible for 75,405 jobs in 2023 (36,227 direct jobs and 39,178 indirect and induced jobs.
- \$35 billion in total sales for our industry last year.
- \$3 billion in total payroll with average annual earnings of \$81,523.
- \$1.1 billion in total sales tax collected!

Make no mistake, franchised dealers are second to none in advancing the overall economic prosperity of North Carolina. Our shared commitment to excellence, customer service, and community engagement sets our industry apart as a pillar of our state's economy.

However, it is critical to ensure that every public policy maker in our state is regularly reminded of these facts. As legislators and other policy makers are deciding issues of importance to our industry, they must be keenly aware of the innovative spirit and unwavering dedication of our franchised dealer body.

I ask that every NCADA member make it their mission to keep your local legislators informed on what you do for your community and our state.
