Scholarship Application Deadline: All applications must be received before April 30, 2025

Eligibility Requirements:

- Student must be pursuing a career in Culinary Arts or a related Culinary Field and enrolled in an accredited institution of higher learning, including but not limited to College, University, & Trade School.
- Student must provide high school or college transcripts. Student GPA must be 3.0 or higher.
- Student must be enrolled or have been previously enrolled at a NJ ProStart High school
- Student's permanent address must be in the state of New Jersey
- Application must be accompanied by proof of admission to a school of higher learning and the required essay.
- Student must provide a resume that includes college major

Essay should be 500-1000 words about one of the listed topics below:

- As a chef, why is it important to have an open mind about food and people?
- Write about one thing you have learned during your high school career that you will keep with you for a lifetime.
- What goals do you want to accomplish in the next 5 years? How do you plan to accomplish these goals?
- What life lesson have you learned that can be applied in the kitchen, or conversely, what lesson from your kitchen experiences can be translated to the broader world?
