ABOUT TOWNSHIPS

Townships are grassroots, statutory governments that perform many basic services.

Over 35% of Ohio residents live in a township.

There are 1,308 townships in Ohio that vary in population size, and budget.

Township government is administered by three trustees and one fiscal officer who are elected.

Ohio townships most commonly provide residents with road maintenance, cemetery management, police and fire protection, emergency medical services, solid waste disposal, and zoning.
