POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE Thank you for supporting the PAA!

If you are in rental housing in Pennsylvania, you are in politics. From fair housing policies to rent control, automatic sprinkler retrofits to short-term rental regulations, the members of the PA Senate and House, members of City Councils, and local municipal representatives play a huge role in shaping the policy and economic climate for the rental multifamily housing industry.

PAA PAC is the bi-partisan political action committee that helps supports candidates and our allies within government who understand the needs and concerns of the rental multifamily housing industry.

PAA is prohibited from using general account funds such as membership dues or other revenue to contribute to federal elections. That means PAA PAC, by pooling the individual contributions of members, is the only vehicle through which we and our members may collectively participate in the political process. PAA PAC may only accept personal contributions from members.

Any funds collected are disbursed directly to the campaign of a candidate or incumbent elected official. This donation is heavily regulated and monitored by the Federal Election Commission (FEC).

KEYSTONE AWARDS CALL TO ENTRY COMMUNITY COMPETITION

March 11 - April 30, 2024

Registration online

What is this Event:

• The PAA Keystone Awards (previously Best of Apartment Living Awards) is a friendly competition among apartment communities and management companies in a variety of categories. The competition is based on the style and age of communities in the state. A third-party firm will judge your community. All results will be tabulated, and winners will be announced at the 'PAA Keystone Awards Celebration'. Each region of the state will have a competition and awards program. In most categories, the property will be 'mystery shopped' which simply means you will not know who the judge will be or when they are coming. The judge will pretend they are seeking an apartment and rate the community according to the categories entered in the contest. PAA created our awards program as a training tool for our Management Companies and site teams.

Who Should Register:

• PAA management company members are encouraged to participate!

Trilogy Award Package \$625/entry

The Trilogy Award Package allows a property management company or property to register for all three community categories in one form.

LEASING EXCELLENCE - Communities will be judged specifically on how well the property leases apartments. Judging includes reviewing the property's website, response to leasing questions via the internet, and an in-person tour. The judge will review every aspect of the leasing process. This is a 'mystery shop'.

MAINTENANCE EXCELLENCE - Communities will be judged specifically on how well the property maintains apartments. Judging includes a site visit to the property with a review of the maintenance shop. The judge will review every aspect of maintaining the property. A shop will be scheduled with the property.

OVERALL EXCELLENCE - Communities will be judged specifically on how well the property scores overall. Judging includes reviewing the property's website, response to leasing questions via the internet, and an in-person tour. The judge will review every aspect of the leasing process. Evaluations for the Leasing Excellence and Overall Excellence Categories will take place May 15th through the end of August 2024. All Maintenance Excellence shops will start as of May 30th through August 31st, 2024. The top three highest scores win based on size, price, type, and community age.



Management Company of the Year \$100/entry

To be considered for this award, the management company must enter this category and the Leasing, Excellence, Maintenance Excellence and Overall Excellence. ONE entry per management company. The Management Company who has the highest average score wins Management Company of the Year across the state.

KEYSTONE AWARDS CALL TO ENTRY INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

March 11 - April 30, 2024

Registration online

Regional, Assistant, and Property Managers of the Year - \$125 To enter these categories, the Property Manager's community MUST be entered in Leasing, Maintenance, and Overall Excellence categories. The candidate is required to complete a questionnaire and submit a video. There will be a Regional Property Manager, Property Manager, and Assistant Property winner for each region.

Leasing Professional of the Year - \$125

To enter this category, Leasing Professional's community MUST be entered in both Leasing and Community Overall Excellence categories. The Leasing Excellence judging is based upon the candidate's property performance, leasing statistics, customer service philosophy, and credentials. The candidate is required to complete a questionnaire and submit a video. There will be a Leasing Professional winner for each region.

Maintenance Professional of the Year - \$125

To enter this category, the Maintenance Professional's community MUST be entered in both Maintenance and Community Overall Excellence categories. The Maintenance Excellence judging is based upon the property's overall service, production schedule, service request completions, expenses, and preventative maintenance programs. The candidate is required to complete a questionnaire and submit a video. There will be a Maintenance Professional winner for each region.

Rookie of the Year - \$125

This award is given to a NEW employee at the apartment community who has been there for 3 – 9 months and is new to the industry! The rookie should be nominated by their immediate supervisor (Property or Lead Service Technician). The nominating party is required to complete a questionnaire and video as to why this person deserves to be Rookie of the Year. There will be a Rookie of the Year winner for each region.



***All apartment communities who enter all three categories; Leasing, Maintenance, and Overall Excellence will automatically be entered to compete for Top 10 Best of Living! The 10 communities with the highest average scores will be announced.
