# Chemical Abstracts Service (CAS) Registry Numbers

---

- Spoke to Lois Bishop Oct. 9 concerning CAS policy on changing CAS numbers
- Not the policy of CAS to unilaterally change registry numbers. Can be done in discussion with company applying for a new number if they wrongly numbered the starting material.
- Old numbers are sometimes deleted if two numbers describe exactly the same substance are merged
- She does not believe that CAS unilaterally generated new CAS numbers from EC numbers.
- CAS does not publish changes to the registry. You have to query the Inventory for deleted/changed numbers
- She would like any specific examples differing from this policy
