The awards program is owned and managed by the Printing & Imaging Association of Georgia (PIAG). The award-winning companies are honored at the 2025 imPRESS Celebration of Print. Judging

A total of 105 entries were submitted across the awards program from ten print companies and four graphic arts schools from around the state. The criteria for judging are registration, neatness and clarity, sharpness of halftones and line drawings, richness and tonal qualities of color, paper and ink selection, ink coverage, difficulty of printing, effective contrast or softness, overall visual impact, creativity and innovation, and finishing techniques.
