### Press Operator Heidelberg SX-102 8/Color with CutStar Attachment

At RLG Healthcare I was a press operator on a Heidelberg 40" 8/Color SX-102 with a CutStar attachment. RLG Healthcare prints patient information sheets for the pharmaceutical industry. PI sheets are printed on very thin paper. Depending on the availability of paper I would switch from using the CutStar roll converter to regular sheet-fed mode.

#### Press Operator Komori GL 640 UV

At First Impression, I was a press operator on a Komori GL 640 UV. It had a coater unit. I would run various types of coating materials ranging from low gloss to high gloss UV coating. It came equipped with a PQA system which checked for imperfections during the press run. It also came equipped with a PDC-S Auto Tracking Spectrophotometer that I found especially useful for measuring dot gain and for taking L\*a\*b\* readings. I would also take L\*a\*b\* readings at specified x-y positions on the sheet with a hand-held densitometer.

First Impression was a commercial packaging company that did mostly carton packaging for the pharmaceutical and food industry.
