



Authorization to Test

In order to become credentialed as a Certified Portable Sanitation Professional (CPSP) or Apprentice (CPSA), candidates must first acquire an authorization to test (ATT). Once it is determined that you are eligible to test, you have submitted all necessary documentation, and you have paid the appropriate fee, an ATT number will be issued. You will then have up to one year to take the exam. Your ATT will expire one year from the date of approval and your payment will be forfeited. Eligibility criteria for obtaining an ATT include:

- Valid driver’s license
- Ability to read, speak, and write the English language
- Physical strength and agility to perform the tasks required of the position
- Commitment to upholding the CPSP Code of Ethics (available for review on psai.org)

To begin the process of applying for an ATT please complete the form below. Once the PSAI receives the form and appropriate fee, you will be asked to submit a photocopy of your driver’s license and an attestation form completed and signed by a supervisor from your company or some other person who can verify certain aspects of your eligibility.
