2024 Year End Tax Planning & Update Course Description:

This session will review tax and financial changes preparers need to be aware of for the 2024 tax season. The session will take a practical look at law changes, relevant IRS releases, form changes, and other items that will affect tax return preparation.

Tentative topics include Final and Proposed Regulations for Inherited Retirement Plans; SECURE 2.0 provisions; digital currency update; expiration of TCJA; 1099-K, State law updates; and Corporate Transparency Act updates.
