# WATER OPERATOR CERTIFICATION



### **FEES**

There are a few different fees associated with operator certification. When you register for the class you will pay for the class only. The exam fee is separate from the cost of the class. It is also separate from the cost of books, which are optional to purchase.

The costs of the class include:

- CLASS: \$250
- COST OF EXAM: \$174
- COST OF BOOKS: \$65-\$170 (OPTIONAL)

# **COURSE INFORMATION**

The course is a three-day training that will cover the aspects required to know in order to be a qualified water operator. The cost of the course includes a packet of the slides, study resources, and other useful materials.

The course will be administered online. You will be sent a link to the enter the class the week of the event date. You must be registered through our website, before a link for the class will be sent to you. The link will be specific to the email you registered with, so please make sure the attendee's email Is the one you use on the registration.

As this class is online, you will be required to have access to a laptop and internet access. If there are systems with multiple attendees, each attendee must be registered but you can all watch on one account. Just make sure that Is made clear to the class administrator the first day of class.

Depending on the teacher and the class content, class end times may vary. For the online course, you will have access to the teacher. You will be able to submit questions, raise your hand, and speak if you'd like. The class administrator will monitor the chat and questions for each class.

### **EXAM INFORMATION**

Paper exam for the water operator certification exam are only offered at RWAU's Annual and Fall Conference (FEB/AUG). If you would like to take that exam you will need to register with the Division of Drinking Water (DDW). Paper exams cost \$240. To pass the exam you need to score a 70% or above. There are 100 questions, multiple-choice style.

If you would like the test any other time, you will need to apply through RWAU's online proctor exam program. RWAU proctors the online exam either in our office in Alpine, UT or we send a proctor out to your system (if the need is necessary). To register for an online exam you will need to contact Morgan in the main office.

Before any exam will be scheduled, you will need to submit the exam application and fee. If you have not taken an exam before, you will need to the exam application notarized. The exam application and all other exam information will be included in your confirmation email.
