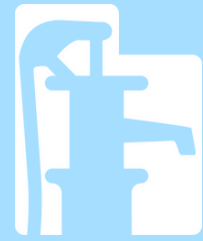


WATER OPERATOR CERTIFICATION



FEES

The only fee paid to RWAU is the course fee. Optional textbooks and exams are paid separately and to the respective organizations. The course fee includes access to the course and a class study guide.

The cost of books and the exam fee are separate and registration for the exam is separate. The books are not required, only suggested, and the link to the books we suggest will be in your confirmation email.

MANUAL

The manuals are optional through the University of California, *Sacramento*.

COURSE INFORMATION

The course is a three-day training that will give a general overview of the aspects required to know in order to be a qualified water operator. The cost of the course includes access to the course and a course study guide.

The course will be administered online. You will be sent a link to enter the class one week of the event date. You must be registered for the class before a link for the class will be sent to you. The link will be specific to the email you registered with, so please make sure the attendee's email is the one you use on the registration.

As this class is online, you will be required to have access to a laptop and internet access. If there are systems with multiple attendees, each attendee must be registered but you can all watch on one account. Just make sure that is made clear to the class administrator the first day of class.

Depending on the teacher and the class content, class end times may vary. For the online course, you will have access to the teacher. You will be able to submit questions, raise your hand, and speak if you'd like. The class administrator will monitor the chat and questions for each class.

EXAM INFORMATION

Paper exam for the water operator certification exam are only offered at RWAU's Annual and Fall Conference (FEB/AUG). If you would like to take the paper exam you will need to register with the Division of Drinking Water (DDW).

If you would like the online version of the exam, you can do so at any time throughout the year. You will need to apply through RWAU's online proctor exam program. RWAU proctors the online exam either at our office in Bluffdale. You will test here if your system is within a 50 mile radius of the office. If your system is outside the 50-mile radius, we will send a proctor out to your system. To register for an online exam please visit our website (rwau.net) for more details.

Before any exam will be scheduled, you will need to submit the exam application and fee. If you have not taken an exam before, you will need to the exam application notarized. The exam application and all other exam information will be included in your confirmation email.
