### FEES

### COURSE INFORMATION

The course is a three-day training that will give a general overview of the aspects required to know in order to be a qualified wastewater operator. The cost of the course includes access to the course and a study guide.

The course will be administered online. You will be sent a link to enter the class a week prior to the course start date. You must be registered before a link for the class will be sent to you. The link will be specific to the email you registered with, so please make sure the attendee's email is the one you use on the registration.

In order to track attendees, and CEUs, one link for one attendee. If you have questions or concerns, please contact RWAU as soon as possible to work out any issues regarding this requirement.

As this class is online, you will be required to have access to a laptop and internet access. If there are systems with multiple attendees, each attendee must be registered but you can all watch on one account. Just make sure that is made clear to the class administrator the first day of class.

Depending on the teacher and the class content, class end times may vary. For the online course, you will have access to the teacher. You will be able to submit questions, raise your hand, and speak if you'd like. The class administrator will monitor the chat and questions for each class.

### EXAM INFORMATION

Exams for the state wastewater operator certification are offered at the RWAU Annual (FEB-Saint George) and Fall (AUG- Layton) conferences. Paper exams are no longer offered at any other time. There is an online exam option as well. Exams are administered through the Division of Water Quality (DWQ).
