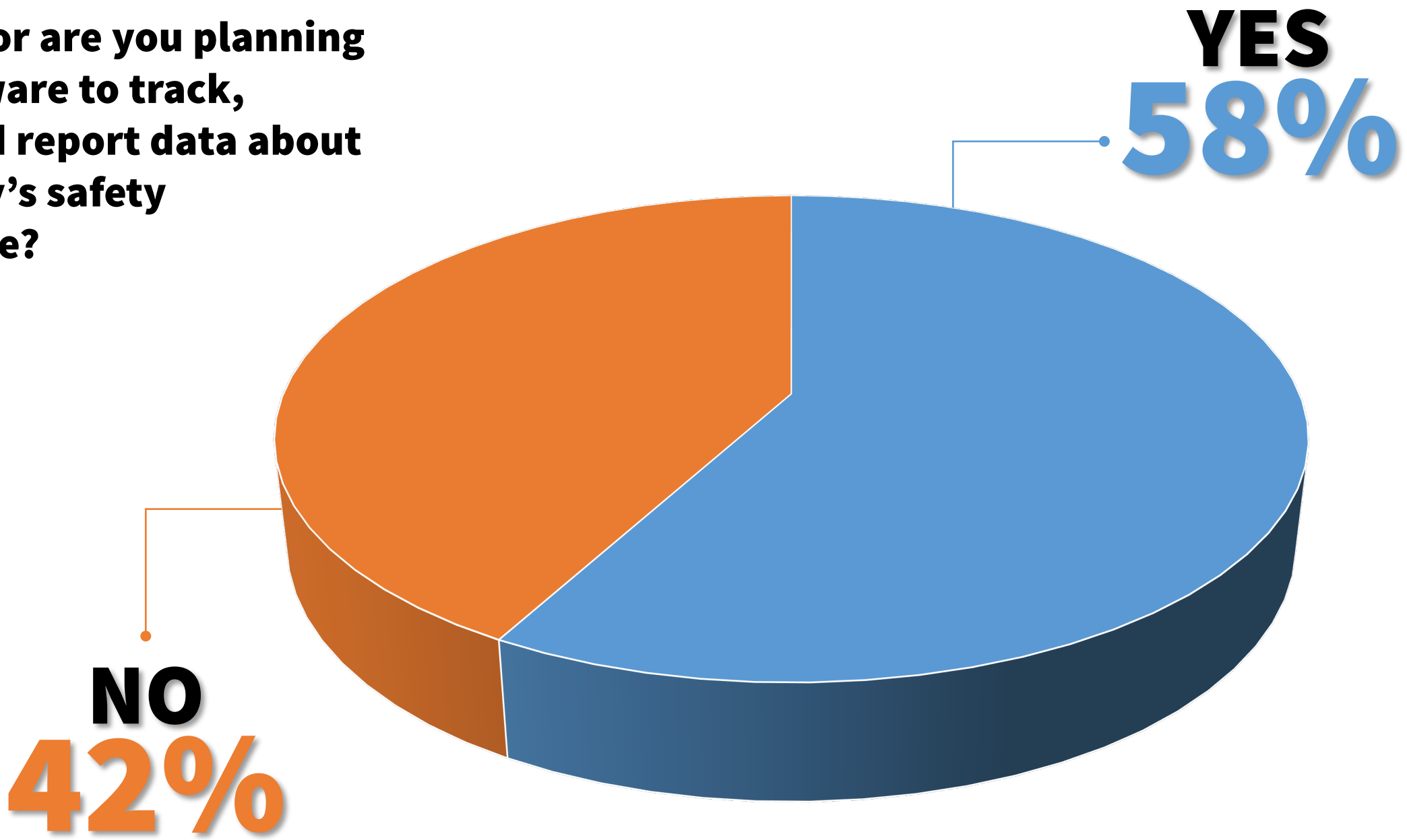

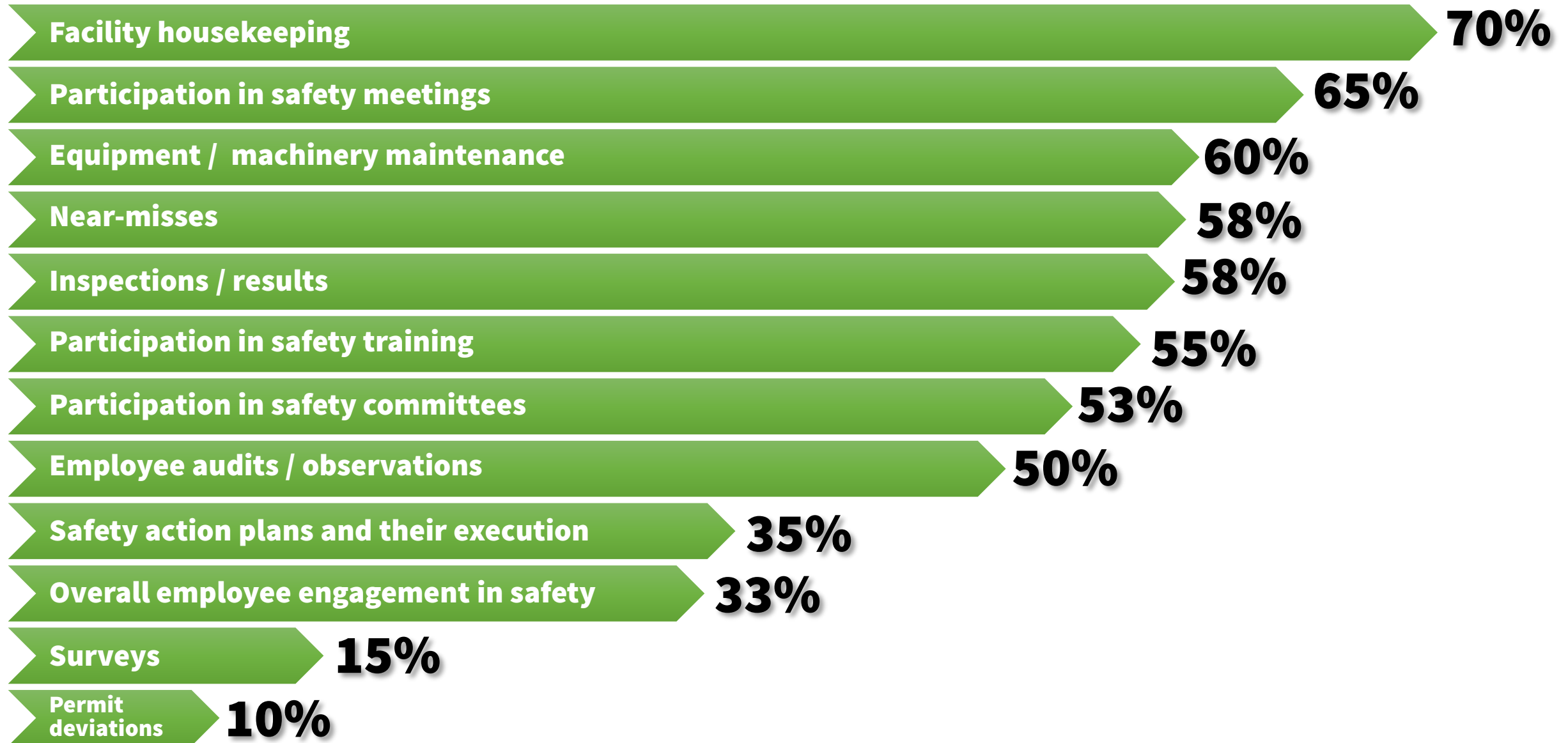

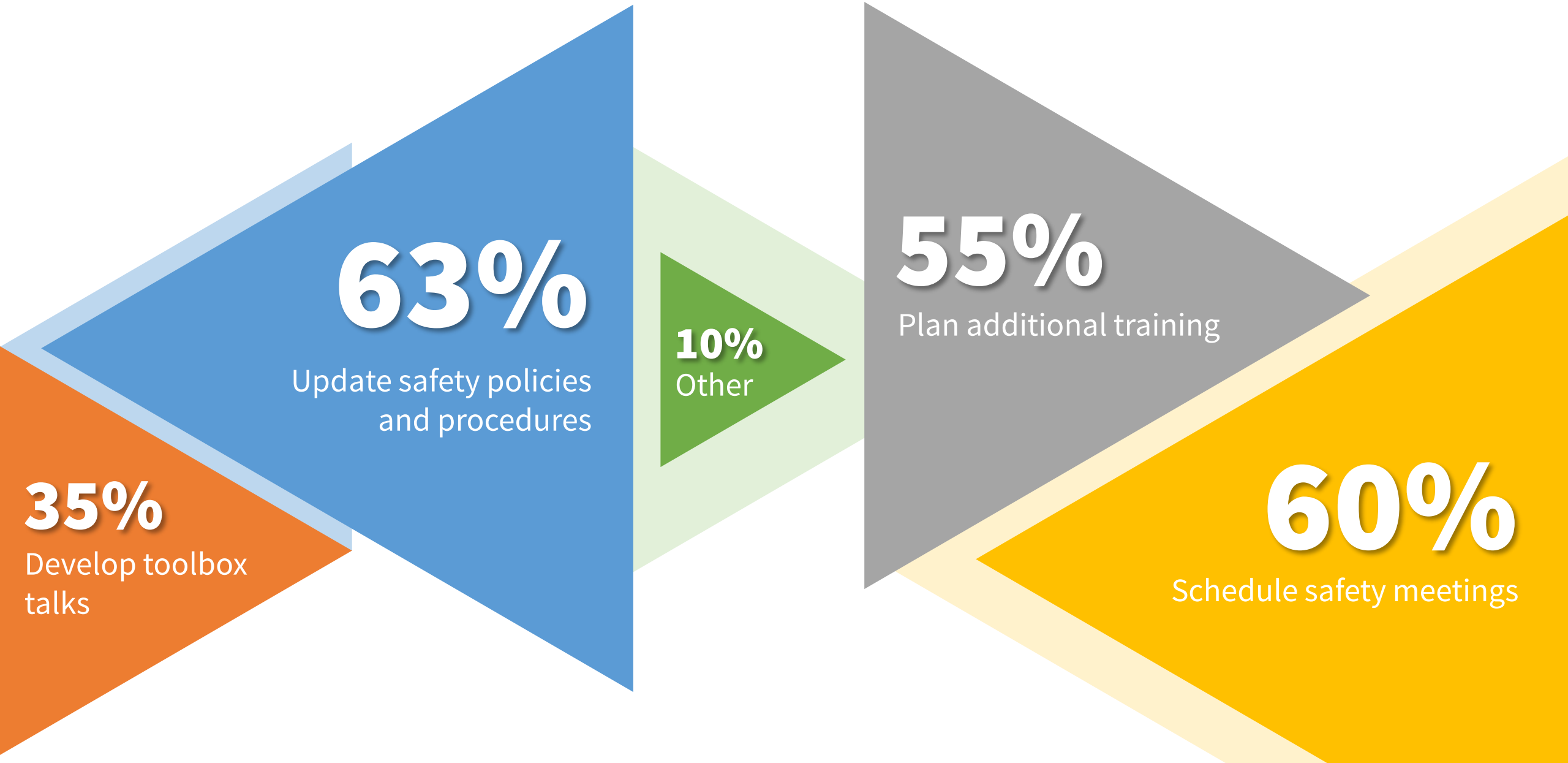
Do you use or are you planning to use software to track, manage and report data about your facility's safety performance?

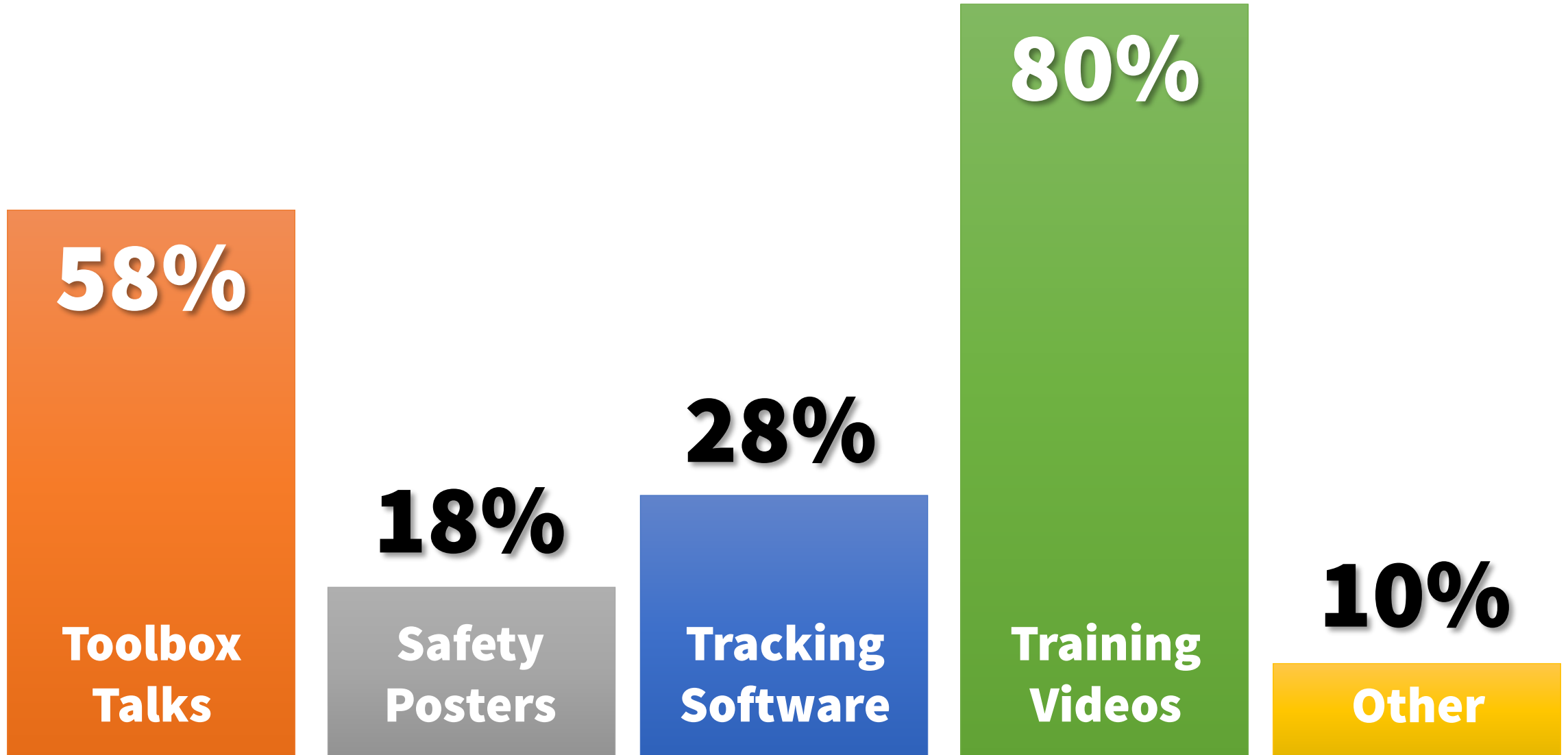
