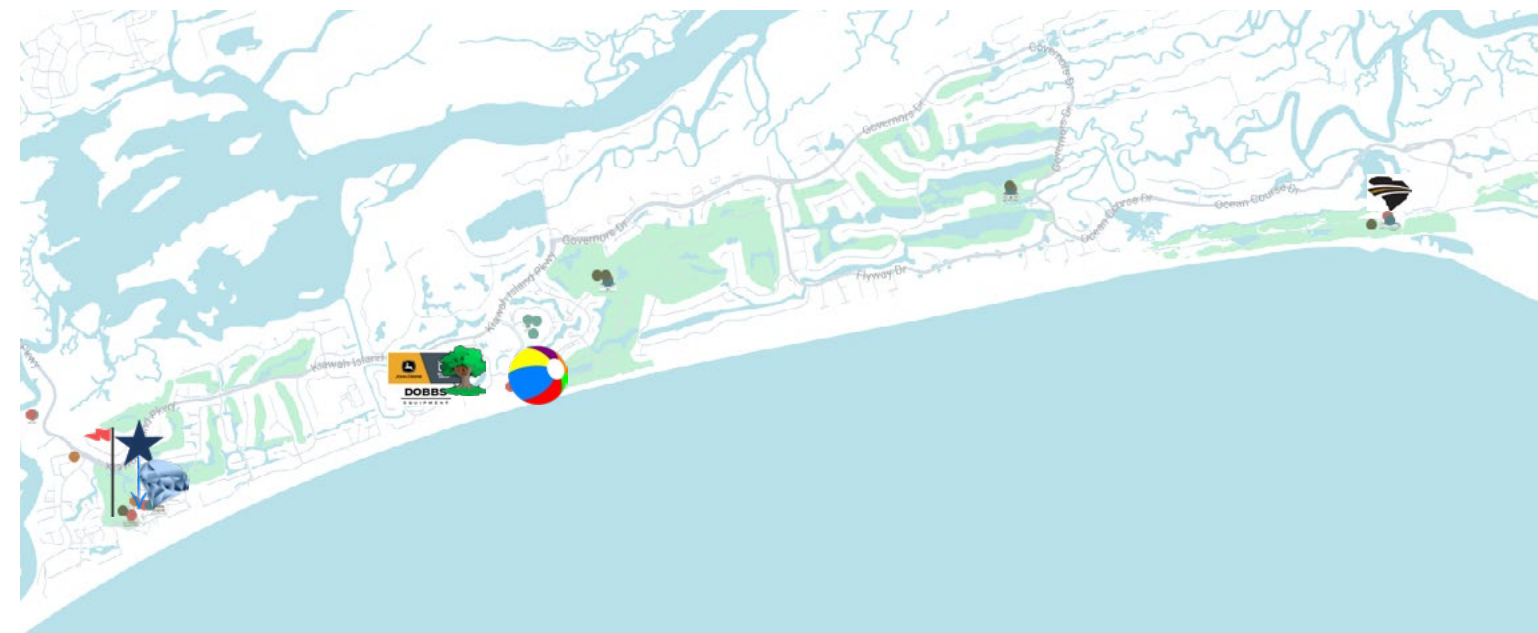
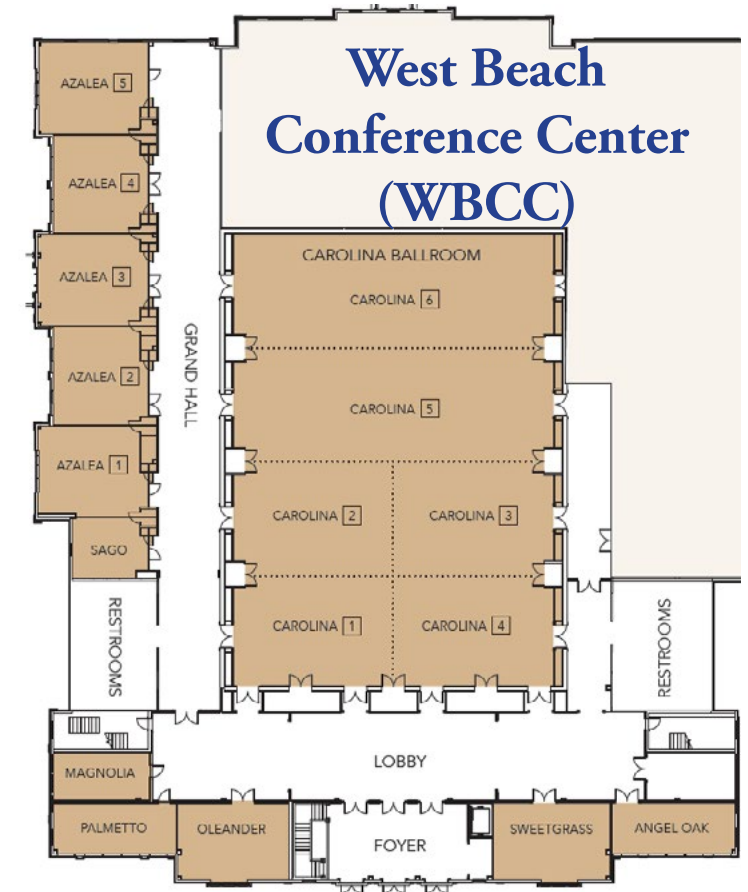

Beach Access to Reserved Chairs (Friday & Saturday)

West (right) of the Sanctuary Emergency Beach Access

SCAPA has reserved umbrellas and chairs for our attendees on Friday and Saturday. Look for the green umbrellas with the SCAPA logo on the back. They are located at the Sanctuary Access: West (right) of the Sanctuary Emergency Beach Access.

Additional Beach Access:

Boardwalk 22: 100 yards east of the boardwalk (4 minute walk) towards the Sanctuary

Boardwalk 27: Turtle Beach / Maritime Villas west (right) to the Sanctuary



Transportation

Kiawah Island shuttles vary based on where you are staying. If you book through the Kiawah Island Golf Resort, you have access to free on-island shuttles. Guests renting private homes or Airbnbs must rely on personal vehicles or private airport transfers, as rideshares are limited on the island.

1. Kiawah Island Golf Resort Guests (On-Island Service)

Registered guests of the resort have complimentary, door-to-door on-island transportation.

- How to book: Call extension 82900 from any resort phone.
- Wait times: Usually 10 to 15 minutes but can be more.
- Public Shuttle Route: The resort also operates an open-air/standard public island shuttle. Pickups generally operate from 6:30 am to 7:45 am and 9:00 am to 4:00 pm, with extended hours on Fridays. Shuttles arrive approximately every 15 minutes and stop at key locations like the East Beach Parking Lot, Night Heron Park, and the Roy Barth Tennis Center.

** Note: This exclusive service is only provided to Kiawah Island Golf Resort guests (The Sanctuary Hotel and resort-managed villas/homes).*

2. Private/Non-Resort Guests

If you are staying in a privately managed villa or home, you do not have access to the free resort shuttle.

- Rideshares: Uber operate trips to the island, but they are generally unavailable for getting around on the island, and empty ride-hail returns to the mainland can result in massive delays.

3. Off-Island & Airport Transportation

- Local Car Services: Companies such as Island Transportation offer set fares starting around (\$150) per way for up to two passengers. Other popular, pre-booked options include Marquee Limo Company and Lowcountry Luxury Limo.

4. Driving

Should you choose to drive to the West Beach Conference Center, there is a surface lot (pool lot) to the right or a parking garage underneath. Space is limited.

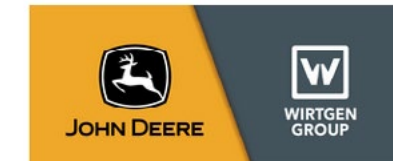
