

- Office of Management and Budget (OMB) issued final guidance on August 23, 2023, for implementation of the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) provisions of the IIJA

IIJA Funding – DOT/OIG Fraud Awareness

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA) includes a 5-year reauthorization (FY22-26) of surface transportation programs and a direct advanced appropriations 5-year package valued at over \$660 billion.

➤ Bridge Formula Program: \$28 billion (5 years)

➤ Charging and Fueling Infrastructure Grants \$2.5 billion

➤ Charging Formula Program \$5 billion

➤ Bridge Investment Program: \$16 billion

➤ National infrastructure Investments: \$15 billion

➤ Significant Freight & Highway Projects: 14 billion
