

SEFAA 3rd Fishing for APAC Tournament COVID-19 Safety & Mitigation Plans

This Safety and Mitigation Plan (the "Plan") is adopted to address protocols and procedures to be followed by participants at SEFAA's 3rd Annual Fishing For APAC to avoid any risk of contagion of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

In light of the current public health and safety climate, SEFAA has established the following important changes to this event:

- Pre-event participant <u>self-assessment screening</u>. Staff, volunteers, and participants will execute a Self-Assessment pre-screening stating that they have not experienced any symptoms identified by the CDC as possible indicators of contagion.
- We kindly ask anyone that is feeling ill or exhibiting flu-like symptoms to please hold off on attending any SEFAA programs, out of respect for fellow members and participants.
- Be mindful of everyone's space and ask before greeting a fellow member.
- Complimentary tissues and **hand sanitizing stations** will be available onsite throughout the charters and event.
- All attendees will be <u>required</u> to always wear a mask/gaiter regardless of their vaccination status for COVID-19.
- Attendees are encouraged to use proper hygiene and wash their hands as frequently as possible.
- Staff will be responsible for cleaning and disinfecting all areas, focusing especially on frequently touched surfaces.
- Signs that promote the daily practice of preventive actions will be featured throughout the event.
- Rod blocks will be added in between rod holders to allow proper social distancing between participants.
- Upper deck will be designated as the social distancing lounge, for those participants wanting additional space in between.
- No Smoking on-board
- Participants and volunteers will be required to execute a special Release and Waiver of Liability regarding COVID-19.
- Registration must be completed online prior to the event. In-person registration will not be available at this event.



- Rules and other participant information will be distributed to participants electronically.
- There will be no self-service of food, drinks, snacks, or SWAG. Staff will be handing out all items to each participant.
- SEFAA Safety Crew will be monitoring that everyone aboard adheres to safety guidelines set forth by SEFAA regarding self-screening, the number of people on a vessel and the application of social distancing as mandated by event organizers.
- Similarly, while involved in the event, staff, volunteers, and participants agree to stay home when sick; cover coughs and sneezes; wash hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds; use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60 percent alcohol; avoid touching their eyes, nose and mouth; and properly disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects.
- SEFAA strongly encourages anyone at increased risk for complications from COVID-19 due to underlying health conditions or age to stay home and not participate in the Tournament.
