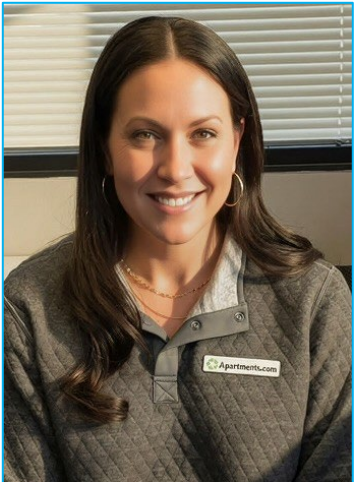


**Angelina Kovalenko**
