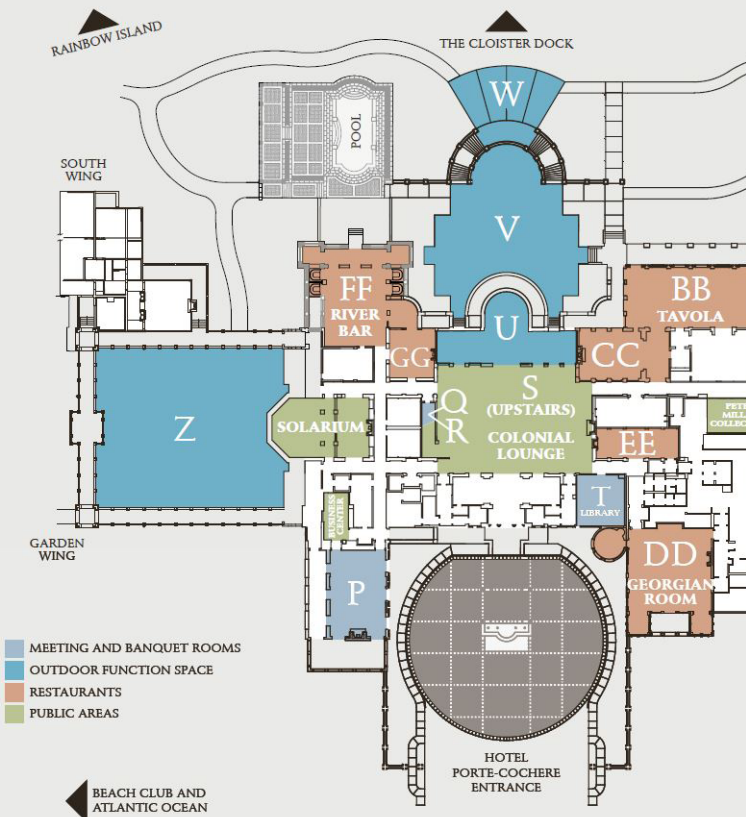

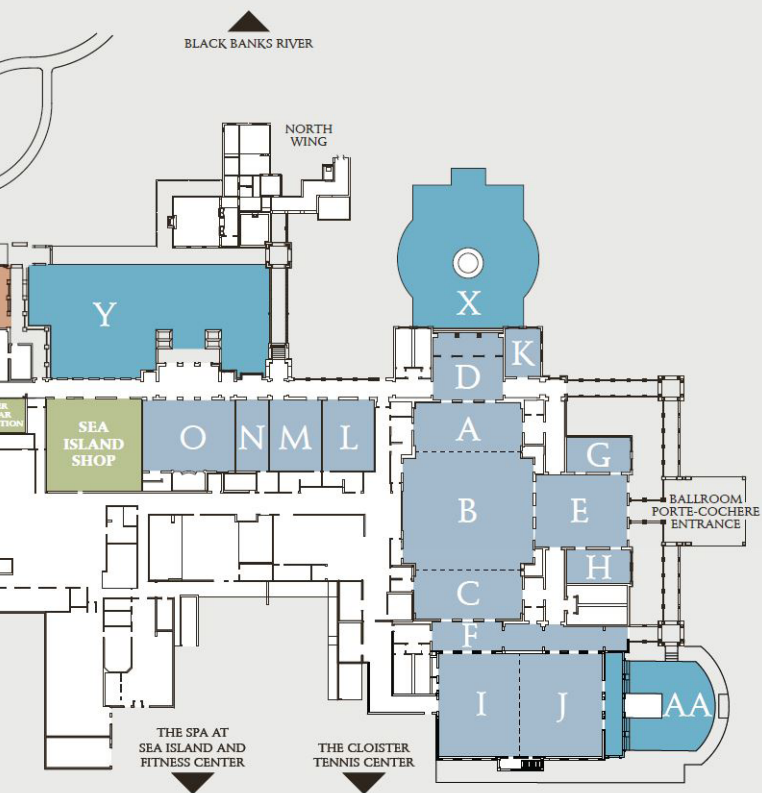

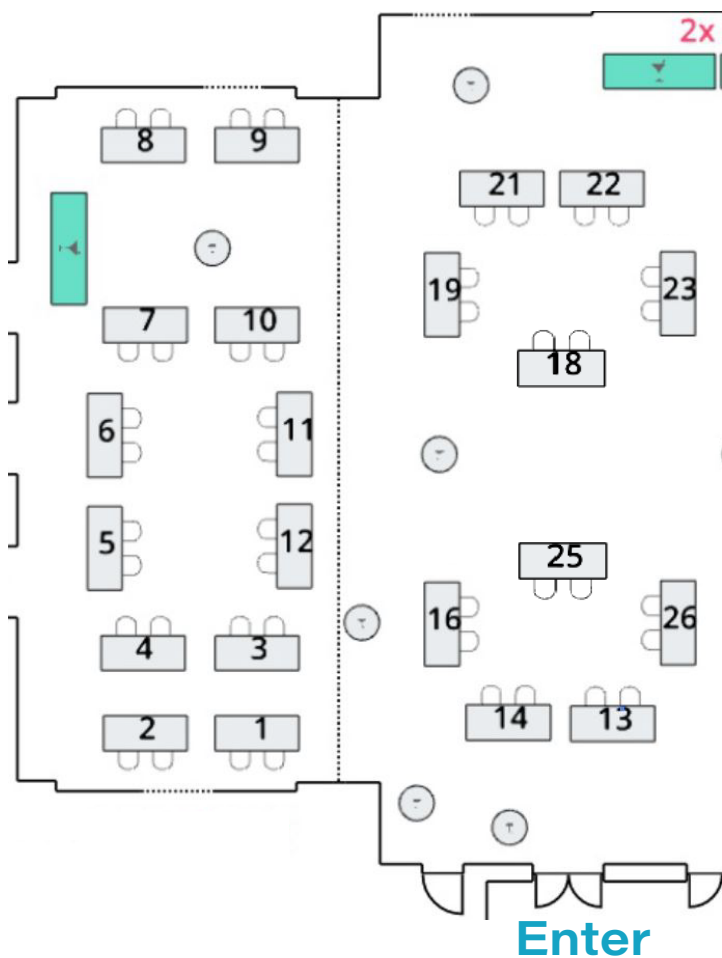

KEYNOTE & BUSINESS SPEAKERS

Keynote - Greg Sankey

Greg Sankey became the eighth Commissioner of the Southeastern Conference on June 1, 2015, and immediately embarked on a journey to build upon the SEC's recognized success, strong foundation and rich traditions.

Sankey first joined the SEC staff in 2002 as Associate Commissioner for Governance. He was elevated to Executive Associate Commissioner and Chief Operating Officer for the league office in 2012, becoming responsible for the day-to-day operation of the SEC Office.

Prior to joining the SEC staff, Sankey was Commissioner of the Southland Conference for nearly seven years. He joined the Southland Conference staff in 1992 where he served as both assistant and associate commissioner before he was named commissioner in 1996 at the age of 31.

Prior to his term at the Southland Conference, he was Director of Compliance and Academic Services at Northwestern State University in Natchitoches, LA. While at Northwestern State, Sankey also coached the Demons' golf teams for two years, earning the Golf Coaches Association of America District VI Coach of the Year award in 1991. Before his tenure at Northwestern State, he was the Director of Intramural Sports at Utica College in upstate New York.

A native of Auburn, NY, Sankey earned his master's degree from Syracuse University and his undergraduate degree from the State University of New York College at Cortland. Sankey and his wife, Cathy, reside in Birmingham, AL, and have two adult daughters, Hannah (and her husband, Rod) and Moriah (and her husband Austin).

Ryan Flom

Ryan Flom is the Chief Marketing Officer of the Softwood Lumber Board, an industry-funded initiative established to promote the benefits and uses of softwood lumber products in outdoor, residential, and non-residential construction. With 20+ years of experience in media, marketing, and business development, he joined the SLB in 2018 and has elevated the SLB's funded programs – ensuring the organization's investments in research, education, building codes and standards as well as design/build consulting, support AEC stakeholders and to grow the market for softwood lumber.

Wood Innovations has focused on mass timber, innovative wood products and renewable wood energy through grants to support education and building project assistance, special communication initiatives, and technical assistance. For over 30 years, Brian has focused on supporting the connection between forestry and forest products, helping support and advance wood products through research, market development and outreach. Brian earned a BS degree in Forestry from the University of Wisconsin–Stevens Point, a MS degree in Wood Materials Engineering from Washington State University, and a PhD in Forest Resources from Mississippi State University.

Paul F. Jannke

Paul Jannke is a Principal of Forest Economic Advisors LLC, with a main area of expertise in North American lumber markets. Having spent more than 25 years analyzing lumber markets and providing reliable, insightful forecasts, Paul is the industry's top economic analyst. Beyond North American lumber, Paul has co-authored numerous studies on the international and engineered lumber, timber, bioenergy, and panel industries.
