

SMCA Membership

There has been some confusion in our industry about what it means to be an SMCA Member firm. This paper is meant to help contractors understand the difference between Industry Fund Contributors and SMCA Member Firms.

- All Companies signatory to the Collective Bargaining Agreement with Local #19 are Industry Fund Contributors regardless of their SMCA Membership status.
- All SMCA Member Firms are signatory to the Local Union #19 Agreement AND are Industry Fund Contributors.
- Thus, any company signatory with Local #19 contributes to the Industry Fund, **BUT** not all Industry Fund Contributors are necessarily Members of SMCA.

The SMCA Board of Directors believes that Industry Fund Contributors deserve a high level of service from the Association even though they have not taken the additional steps to become SMCA Member firms. However, there are additional advantages for a company becoming a full-fledged member of the Association.

What is the difference between being a Member and an Industry Fund Contributor?

Industry Fund Contributors are eligible for many of SMCA's services and contribute to the same Industry Fund as SMCA members. However, as an Industry Fund Contributor, your company has no voting rights or input on the policies and labor relations strategies of the Association. Industry Fund Contributors are not eligible to sit on the SMCA Board of Directors or serve as Industry Fund Trustees.
