

Strengthened partnerships via joint clinical publications, educational events, and a new advocacy coalition together with 15 national organizations.



Cultivated **25 MFM** spokespeople to talk to reporters about the intersection between high-risk pregnancy and abortion.



Filed legal briefs in **15 state courts**, as well as federal court defending access to abortion care.



Hosted 10 virtual events for members to share resources and connect with colleagues nationwide.



Engaged successfully in **5 state ballot measures** on abortion.

ADVANCED POLICIES TO OPTIMIZE PREGNANCY OUTCOMES



Led efforts to introduce the Advancing Safe Medications for Moms and Babies Act, a bipartisan bill aimed at better understanding the effects of medications on pregnant and lactating people.



Established the first-ever "SMFM on the Hill" advocacy day.




Participated in coalition efforts to secure permanent Medicaid extension for a full year postpartum.
