

2024 State Abortion Care Policies

Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care*

- ✗ **Abortion care is banned at 15 weeks**, with exceptions to save the pregnant person's health or life
- ✗ **24-hour waiting period** between mandatory in-person counseling and abortion care
- ✗ **Mandatory ultrasound** before abortion care can be provided
- ✗ **State Medicaid coverage of abortion care is banned** except in limited circumstances
- ✗ **Parental consent** is required for minors

Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

Ballot Measure: On Election Day in November, Arizona voters will decide on the [Arizona Abortion Access Act, or Proposition 131](#), which would establish constitutional protections for abortion care up until fetal viability as determined on a case by cases basis by clinicians, with exceptions for the life of the pregnant person.
