


Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care*

- ✓ Abortion care is not restricted based on gestational age
- No waiting period or mandatory counseling
- ✓ A shield law protects abortion care providers from investigations by other states; may cover patients and support organizations
- X State Medicaid coverage of abortion care is banned except in limited circumstances
- **Parental notice** is required for minors







Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

Legislative: Use our <u>interactive map</u> to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

Ballot Measure: On Election Day in November, Colorado voters will decide on <u>Proposition 89</u>, which would provide constitutional protections for abortion care and allow state insurance to cover abortion care.
