
Maryland 2024 State Abortion Care Policies



Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care*

- ✓ Abortion care is not restricted based on gestational age
- √ No waiting period or mandatory counseling
- ✓ State Medicaid covers abortion care, as does private insurance
- A shield law protects abortion care providers from investigations by other states; may cover patients and support organizations
- **X** Parental notice is required for minors
- If parental notice is unavailable, abortion care providers who are licensed medical doctors can waive the requirement on a case by case basis







Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

Legislative: Use our <u>interactive map</u> to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

Ballot Measure: On Election Day in November, Maryland voters will decide on the <u>Right to Reproductive Freedom Amendment</u>, which would enshrine the right to reproductive freedom, including abortion care, in the state constitution.
