
## **Missouri** 2024 State Abortion Care Policies



## Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care\*

- Abortion care is completely banned, with affirmative defenses for the pregnant person's health and life
- **72-hour waiting period** between mandatory in-person counseling and abortion care
- Mandatory ultrasound before abortion care can be provided
- X State Medicaid and private insurance coverage of abortion care is banned except in limited circumstances
- Parental consent is required for minors







## Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

**Legislative**: Use our <u>interactive map</u> to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

**Ballot Measure**: On Election Day in November, Missouri voters will decide on the <u>Right to Reproductive Freedom amendment</u>, or <u>Amendment 3</u>, which would provide constitutional protections for reproductive health care, including abortion care up until fetal viability, except when to save the life, physical, or mental health of the pregnant patient.
