




Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care*

- **Abortion care is banned at "fetal viability,"** with exceptions to save the pregnant person's life or health
- No waiting period or mandated counseling
- √ State Medicaid funds cover abortion care
- Parental notice is required for minors







Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

Legislative: Use our <u>interactive map</u> to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

Ballot Measure: On Election Day in November, Montana voters will decide on the <u>Constitutional Initiative 128</u>, which would establish the right to abortion care until viability, except where medically indicated to protect the life or health of the pregnant person.
