

2024 State Abortion Care Policies

Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care*

- **Abortion care is banned at “fetal viability,”** with exceptions to save the pregnant person’s life or health
- ✓ **No waiting period or mandated counseling**
- ✓ **State Medicaid funds cover abortion care**
- **Parental notice** is required for minors

Ballot Measure: On Election Day in November, Montana voters will decide on the [Constitutional Initiative 128](#), which would establish the right to abortion care until viability, except where medically indicated to protect the life or health of the pregnant person.
