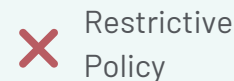
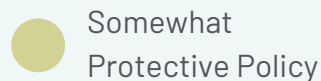
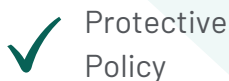


### Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care\*

- **Abortion care is banned at 24 weeks**, with exceptions to save the pregnant person's life or health (including mental health)
- ✓ **No waiting period or mandated counseling**
- ✓ **A shield law** protects abortion care providers from investigations by other states; may cover patients and support organizations
- **State Medicaid coverage of abortion care is banned** except in limited cases. However, a 2024 district court [struck it down](#). The case is being appealed
- ✓ **No parental notice requirement**



### Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

**Legislative:** Use our [interactive map](#) to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

**Ballot Measure:** On Election Day in November, Nevada voters will decide on the [Nevada Right to Reproductive Freedom Act](#) which would establish the right to an abortion care until viability, except where medically indicated to protect the life, physical health, or mental health of the pregnant individual.
