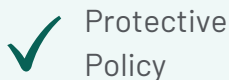


### Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care\*

- ✗ **Abortion care is completely banned**, with exceptions only to save the pregnant person's life.
- ✗ **72-hour waiting period** between mandatory in-person counseling and abortion care
- ✗ **State Medicaid coverage of abortion care is banned** except in limited circumstances
- ✗ **Parental notice** is required for minors

### Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

**Legislative:** Use our [interactive map](#) to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

**Ballot Measure:** On Election Day in November, South Dakota voters will decide on [Constitutional Amendment G](#), which would prohibit the state from regulating abortion care in the first trimester, limit its ability to regulate it in the second trimester, and allow it to limit and even prohibit abortion care in the third trimester, except when to preserve the health or life of the pregnant patient.
