

### Key Policies Impacting Access to Abortion Care\*

- ✗ **Abortion care is completely banned**, with exceptions to save the pregnant person's life and in cases of rape or incest
- ✗ **24-hour waiting period** between mandatory in-person counseling and abortion care
- ✗ **State Medicaid coverage of abortion care is banned** except in limited circumstances
- ✗ **Parental consent** is required for minors

### Current Efforts to Change Access to Abortion Care

**Legislative:** Use our [interactive map](#) to see what policies have been introduced in the state legislature that would impact access to abortion care.

**Ballot Measure:** On Election Day in November, Idaho voters will decide on the [Reproductive Freedom and Privacy Act](#), which would establish the right to abortion care until "fetal viability," with exceptions for patients experiencing medical emergencies.
