

Coding Tip: Coding for Other Conditions in Pregnancy

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The ICD-10-CM diagnosis code book provides in Chapter 15 (codes O00-O9A) a broad variety of diagnoses related to pregnancy—both pregnancy-specific diagnoses and conditions that are complicated or exacerbated by the pregnancy. However, there will be occasions in which the patient has a diagnosis for which a pregnancy-specific code is not available. The exact code(s) to be used will depend on the condition.

Chapter 15 includes variety of options in the **O99** category, "**Other maternal diseases classifiable elsewhere,** but complicating pregnancy, childbirth, and the puerperium." There are separate subcategories within this category for several different conditions or organ systems. The user is to select the primary diagnosis from the relevant condition/organ system subcategory, and then assign a secondary diagnosis for the specific condition. The subcategories in this category are:

Subcategory	Description	Secondary diagnosis options
O99.0-	Anemia	D50-D64
O99.1-	Diseases of the blood and blood forming organs	D65-D89
O99.2-	Endocrine, nutritional, and metabolic diseases	
O99.21-	Obesity	E66
O99.28-	Other endocrine nutritional and metabolic diseases	E00-E89, except E66
O99.3-	Mental disorders and diseases of the nervous system	
O99.31-	Alcohol use	F10
O99.32-	Drug use	F11-F16, F18-F19
O99.33-	Tobacco use	F17
O99.34-	Other mental disorder	F01-F09, F20-F52, F54- F99
O99.35-	Nervous system	G00-G99
O99.4-	Circulatory system	I00-I99
O99.5-	Respiratory system	J00-J99
O99.6-	Digestive system	K00-K93
O99.7-	Skin and subcutaneous tissues	L00-L99

If the patient has a condition that does not fall within any of these categories, then a code **O99.891 Other** specified diseases and conditions complicating pregnancy is selected as the primary diagnosis. Examples of this type of condition could include **M32.9 Systemic lupus erythematosus** or **N18.9 Chronic kidney**

disease, or certain maternal congenital conditions identified in Chapter 17 ("Q" codes). These diagnoses would be reported as a secondary diagnosis, as appropriate.

If the patient has a condition that does not have a specific pregnancy-related diagnosis code, but the clinician believes that the condition is caused directly by the pregnancy, then report ICD-10-CM code **O26.89-Other specified pregnancy related conditions,** ______ trimester. Possible examples include **R10.2 Pelvic and perineal pain** or **M54.50 Low back pain, unspecified**, which are reported as a secondary diagnosis.
