Special Issue: The Use of the Rorschach to Enhance Diagnostic Systems **Guest Editor:** Prof. Radhika Krishnamurthy, Florida Institute of Technology

Deadline of Proposals January 31, 2023 Deadline of Full Papers September 1, 2023

The Editorial Board of *Rorschachiana* is calling for submissions on the use of the Rorschach to enhance diagnostic systems. This special issue will include Rorschach-related concepts/scores and their connection to psychopathology (e.g., concurrent validity of Rorschach scores), the incremental value of Rorschach assessment over diagnoses based on self-report and observer-report, and case studies illustrating the role of the Rorschach in disentangling complicated diagnostic issues. Authors are especially encouraged to submit papers that report on the underlying dynamics, expressed behaviors, and self-attributions of a particular disorder, as well as papers that describe the results of a multimethod assessment with a particular focus on Rorschach data to ultimately provide a contextualized, integrated, comprehensive case study description for the disorder being assessed.

The submission and acceptance process goes through two stages.

Stage 1: Submission of Proposals

Deadline January 31, 2023

Authors submit their proposals in English via email to the Guest Editor at rkrishna@fit.edu.

The proposal includes title, author name(s), contact details, and a short summary (max. 1 page) outlining the topic, method, and results of the submission. Prof. Krishnamurthy will screen the proposals for fit and potential suitability with the topic of the special issue.

Stage 2: Submission of Full Papers

Deadline September 1, 2023

Authors whose proposals were selected by the Guest Editor submit their final manuscripts in English through the journal's <u>online submission system</u>. All submissions will undergo peer review. Author instructions are available at https://www.hogrefe.com/us/journal/rorschachiana

Accepted papers will be published in the second issue of *Rorschachiana* in September 2024. Papers may be published as advance articles before the publication in the issue.
