- What are the requirements for being on a SWFAA Committee?
 Must be a SWFAA member in good standing. We welcome first time volunteers!
- Can Supplier Members also be on committees? Absolutely! We need your input!
- How much meeting time will I have to commit? Standing Committees will
 meet at a minimum of quarterly with Event Committees meeting more
 frequently as events approach. Most meetings are under one hour and are
 facilitated via Zoom.
- How much other work is involved? It really depends on the committee.
 For example, for events, you will need to be present and available on event day along with other footwork prior. For other committees, you may be asked to research issues, communicate with and visit members.
- What if my life gets too hectic to handle my commitment later in the year?
 We appreciate your initiative, but completely understand the unpredictability in our industry. If you frequently miss meetings or are unable to fulfill your obligations, just let us know!
