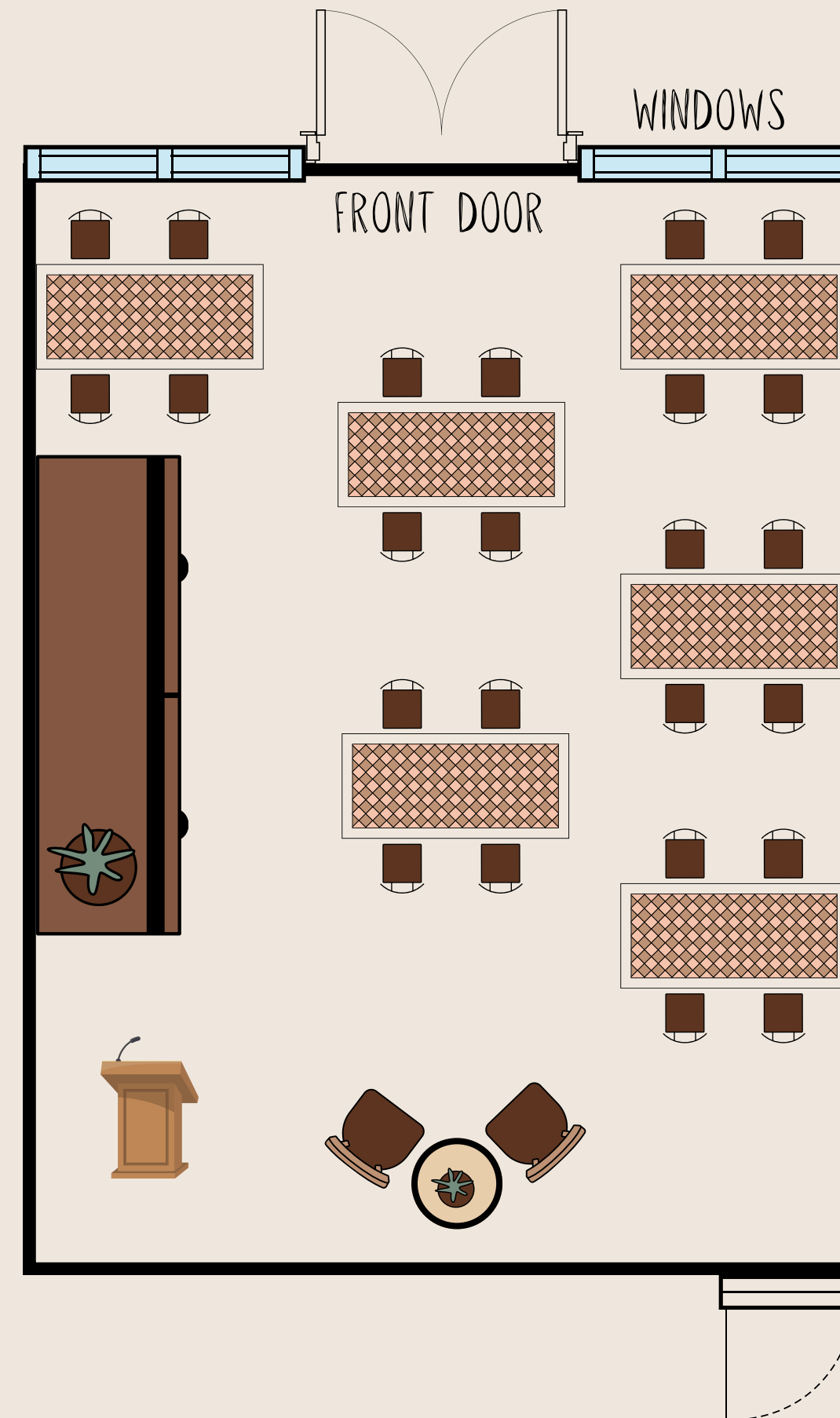




Option #1: Pod Style

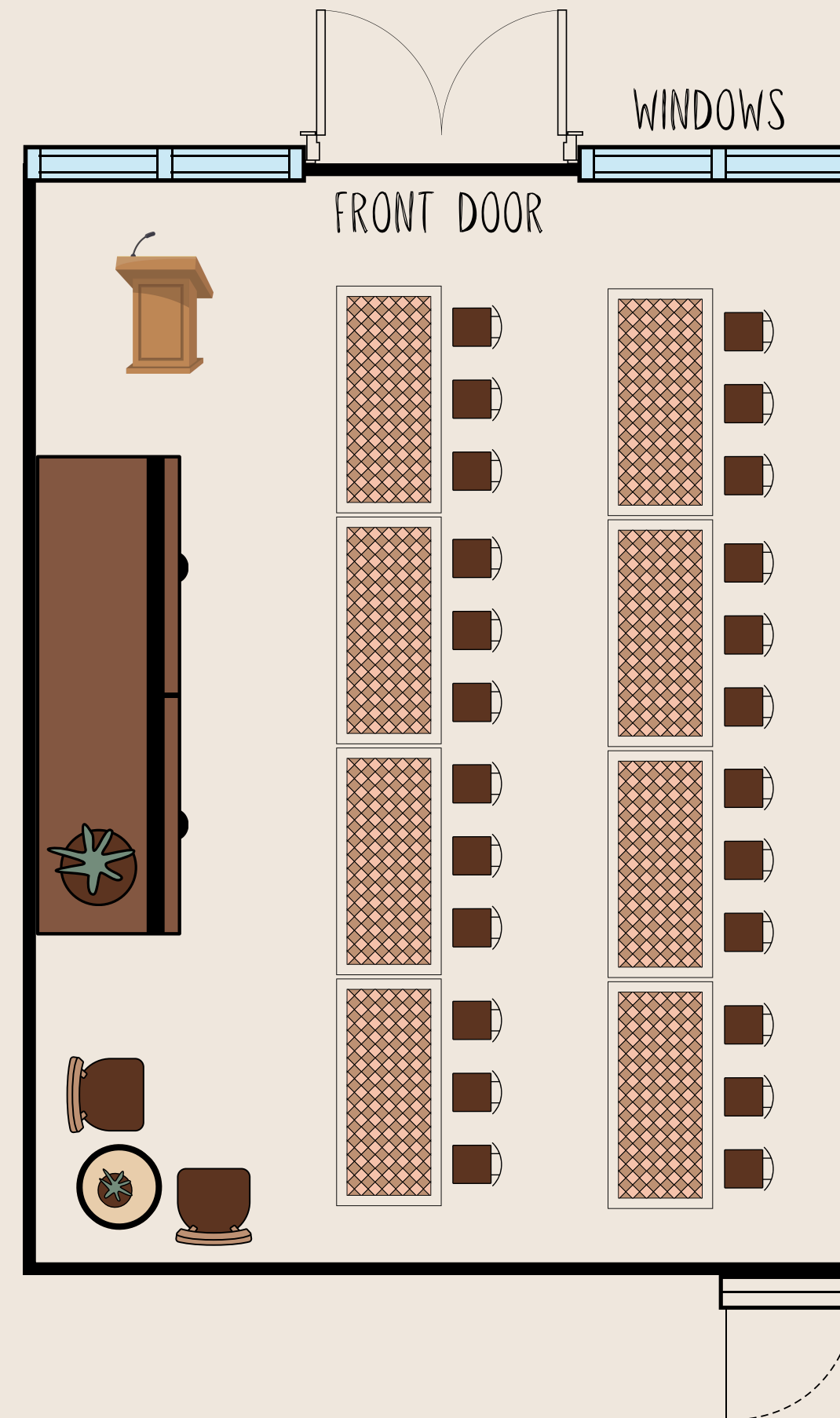
- Seats up to 20-30 people.

Option #2: Classroom Style

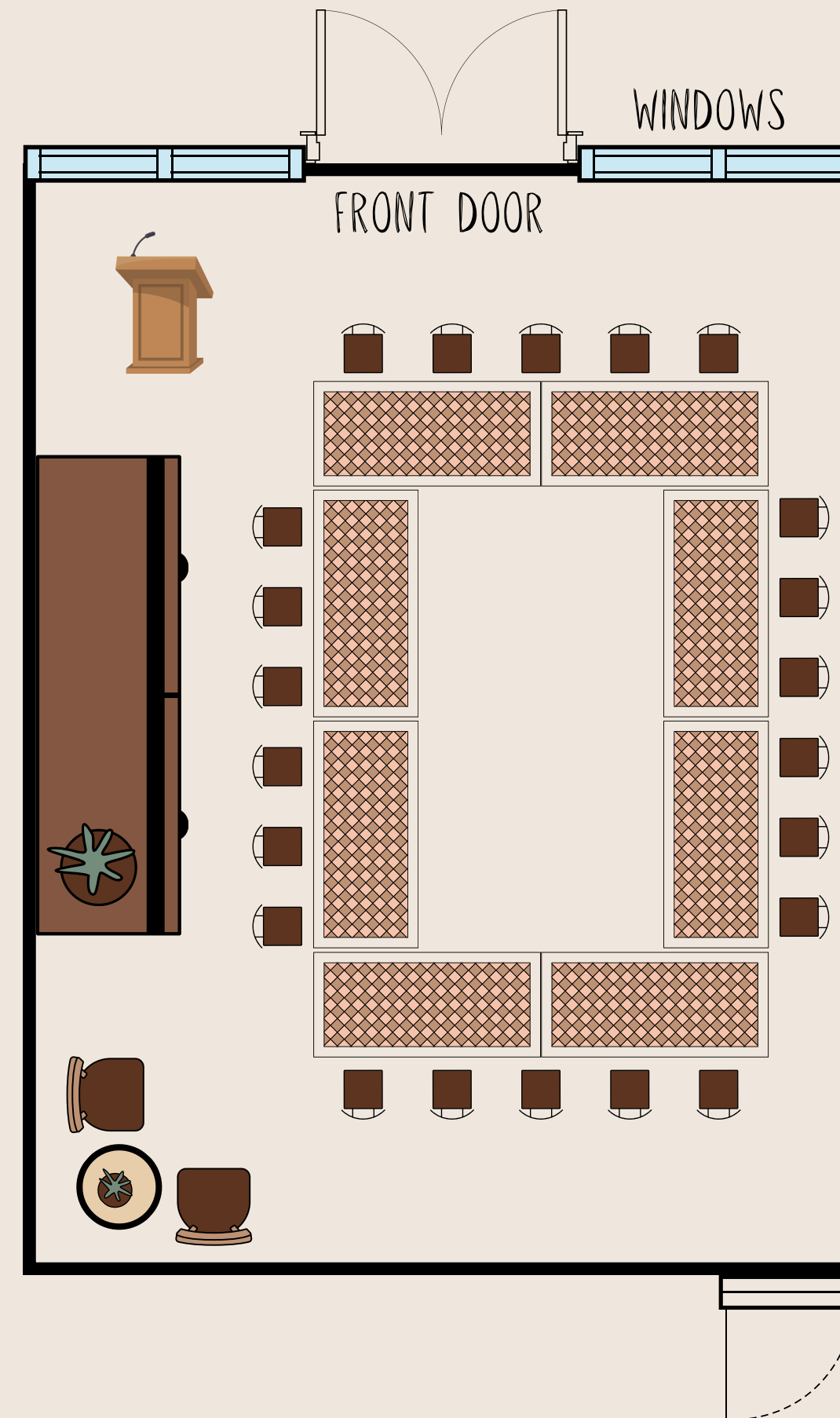
- Seats up to 24 people.

- Seats up to 16 people.
