Emergency Shelter Program (1993)

8-12 weeks Basic Needs, Education, Access to Resources

Aftercare Program (2008)

1 year post program graduation Continued case management services

Transitional Housing Program (2011)


9-12 months Stable housing, life skills attainment, savings

New Lease on Life (2012)

12-24 months permanent, affordable housing Continued case management services

Rapid Rehousing (2015)

12 months Supportive services and financial assistance
