A New Lease on Life & Family Promise of Wake County Interior Renovations Scope of Work Schedule

1. Pre-Construction

- 2 Shipping Containers for Storage
- Port a John
- Roll Off Waste Away Dumpster
- "Pack up" apartment, ready to move out

2. Demolition 1 Day

- General Contractor to lead 4-hr session with each group of 4 volunteers
 - o Move all contents (furniture and boxes) into onsite storage container
 - o Demo
 - Kitchen cabinets, counter, appliances
 - Bathroom cabinets
 - Doors & frames
 - Toilets only if needed
 - Electrical outlets, overhead lights

3. Cabinets, Countertops, & Doors 1 Day

- Cabinetry Supplier
 - o Kitchen Cabinets: White; Full Plywood Box; Shaker Style; Standard Overlay
 - o 3 30" bath vanities w/ cultured marble countertop
 - o 10 linear ft kitchen countertop 22 sq ft countertops (quartz)
- General Contractor to oversee installation with volunteers
 - Install cabinets and countertops provided
 - Doors & frames

4. Paint and Drywall 2 Days

- Paint Contractor labor
 - o Paint ceiling, walls and trim with paint provided.
 - Make necessary drywall repairs and float to a level 3 finish.
 - Exterior front door prepped & painted
- Paint Supplies
 - o 6 buckets of "Agreeable Grey" (30 gal) of paint, 1 bucket ceiling white
 - 4 buckets flat wall
 - 2 buckets semi-gloss kitchen bath
 - o 1 bucket ceiling white
 - 1 bucket trim white
 - Exterior door paint (as needed)

5. Flooring Installation <u>1-2 Days</u> (Timing depends on subfloor issues.)

• Flooring Vendor to install new flooring, repair any subfloor issues, and install shoe molding around cabinets in kitchen and bath.





6. Install turn items 2 Days

- General Contractor to lead with group of 4 volunteers
- Full turn list separate.
 - Window coverings
 - Door hardware package
 - Plumbing package
 - Sinks, faucets, and shower trim
 - Lighting Package
 - o Electrical plate covers
 - o Bathroom hardware package

7. Installation of appliance package ½ Day

- Volunteer to pickup donated appliances from local community and install
 - Management Company or Community to donate stainless appliances.
 Fridge, 30" range/stove, and range hood.
 - Range hood may need to be purchased, most communities offer built-in microwaves.

8. Paint touchup & final punch list 1 Day

- Paint Contractor to return to touch up paint as needed.
- General Contractor to return to complete final punch list

9. Reinstallation of Furniture and Clean 1 Day

 Restoration Contractor to oversee clean and replace furniture and all items to the apartment, and then a full clean of the apartment.

10. Sparkle and WOW fridge ½ **Day** (Schedule the day before the family moves in.)

 Volunteer to lead with group of 2-3 volunteer companies. Volunteers will purchase "sparkle bucket" supplies to leave in the apartment and will purchase items to stock the pantry and fridge.
