If you've been furloughed this year, we are providing a low cost individual membership for you and those new professionals in their first three years working or seeking employment at a museum, historic site, or related institution.



Finally, we've also address the missing rung of our engagement ladder with the new Alumni Membership Level. This was designed specifically for former councilors and committee members who served our organization over the past 40 plus years.

What's New for Institutions? For Institutions, we have long used an organization's operational budget to determine dues, but we know that that may not be the best method for calculating rates.
