

TAMII Pre-Annual Meeting Sentiment Survey




In March 2020, TAM canceled our in-person Annual Meeting and successfully pivoted into the virtual world for the first time. As TAM continues to track COVID's impact on museums and museum professionals, a survey was released at the beginning of September to gauge our community's interest and comfort level to inform our direction for TAM 2021.

How likely are you to attend an in-person conference in San Antonio, in April 2021?



66% combined individuals said they would likely or definitely attend an in-person conference




34% of individuals said they would not or would likely not attend an in-person conference



How likely are you to attend video streamed sessions or keynotes in April 2021?



65% combined individuals said they would likely or definitely attend virtual offerings



25% of individuals said they would not or would likely not attend virtual offerings



Survey participants noted many important items that we're considering in TAM 2021 planning.



HEALTH

Necessary Precautions

- A decentralized format allows for greater control over capacity and movement
- Local venues increased experience in hosting safe events builds confidence in planning
- Safety protocols such as masks and sanitation will be enforced
- Only 43% of respondents expressed concern about health and safety



TRAVEL

Uncertain Restrictions

- 50% of respondents
 noted that they are
 unsure of whether their
 museum will support
 travel
- Featured programming will be streamed live and recorded for those unable to travel to San Antonio



COST

Financial Considerations

- 51% of respondents

 anticipate financial
 support from their
 museum to attend an inperson and/or virtual
 conference
- We will increase efforts to provide scholarships and other financial support to ensure an equitable experiences



CONNECTION

Resilient Networking

- Attendees note that they
 are more likely to attend in person events due to fatigue
 or non-satisfaction
 with virtual events
 Museum professionals have
- Museum professionals have not been able to meet since March 2020 and this will be their first opportunity to connect in a safe, in-person

Flexibility and Choice

- Survey respondents
 revealed they need more
 time to make a decision and
 therefore TAM will provide
 flexible deadlines
- 74% of respondents
 expressed interest in paying
 their own way depending on
 the quality programming
