

# SOUTH CAROLINA'S NONPROFIT SUMMIT HISTORY

In 1998, SCANPO's first statewide conference had over 100 attendees. It is now known as South Carolina's Nonprofit Summit and will draw over 600 attendees. The Summit is one of the largest statewide gatherings for nonprofit leaders in the country and includes plenary sessions with nationally known keynotes, over 40 breakout sessions, site visits, receptions and exhibitors.

# SCANPO'S KEY MILESTONES

- 1997** Received IRS approval, established initial board and hired first executive director.
- 1998** Created a "toll-free" nonprofit help line and held the first statewide conference.
- 1999** Advocated for revisions to SC's Charitable Solicitations Act and reduced fees for criminal background checks.
- 2000** Launched the first website and offered pro bono legal services through the SC Bar.
- 2001** Published the first Compensation Survey and hosted the first Nonprofit Day at the Capitol.
- 2002** Published the first SC Nonprofit Sector Report. Held Three-Sector Public Policy Conference.
- 2003** Presented first Award for Nonprofit Excellence.
- 2004** Disseminated the first monthly electronic newsletter and compiled a consultant database.
- 2005** Established Secretary of State Nonprofit Advisory Council.
- 2006** Launched Preserving the Public Trust Initiative, which led to development of Guiding Principles & Best Practices.
- 2007** Released the first edition of Guiding Principles and offered related training. Held first Executive Round Table.
- 2008** Updated SC Nonprofit Sector Report sharing the economic impact of nonprofits.
- 2009** Released second edition of the Guiding Principles.
- 2010** Secured federal stimulus grant for nonprofit capacity building.
- 2011** Rebranded with new logo and tagline. Launched new website with online member renewal and updated Career Center. Held listening sessions across the state.
- 2012** Published third edition of the Guiding Principles, expanding from seven to nine principles. Held related trainings across the state. Published Compensation Report. Opened membership to Academic Institutions.
- 2013** Established regional membership committees and began holding regular gatherings across the state.
- 2014** Began hosting weekly webinars. Updated Sector Impact Report. Held Public Policy Day in conjunction with United Way Association of SC. Offered first Giving Day social media training in conjunction with Central Carolina Community Foundation and others.
- 2015** Charitable raffles became legal after many years of advocacy efforts led by SCANPO.  
Began offering Board Engagement Services. Summit at Isle of Palms sold out with over 500 participants.  
Launched weekly Nonprofit News — landing in inboxes every Monday. Upgraded to mobile friendly website, adding online member, grantmaker and business partner directories.
- 2016** Held first Board Leadership Summit with The Citadel. Summit participation topped 700.  
Career Center utilization reached a new high with 141 jobs posted in May.
- 2017** In its 20th year, as membership exceeds 800 your nonprofit network will rebrand, begin implementing a new strategic plan, publish the fourth edition of the Guiding Principles, partner with the Sisters of Charity Foundation of SC to launch Carolina Leadership Seminars, host ten regional gatherings and hold Board Leadership Summits across the state.
