SC Nonprofit Summit Audience Profile & Satisfaction




What is the impact of the SC Nonprofit Conference?

Satisfaction

- The overall survey resulted in a 4.3 satisfaction score
- **48%** of respondents rated the conference with a **5 out of 5**.
- Scholarship recipients rated the conference with a 4.7 out of 5.

- Overwhelmingly, people referred to the power and importance of **networking and relationship-building**.
 Several reflected that the Summit increased their confidence to network and build relationships.
- Many shared that the Summit underscored the necessity of collaboration and partnerships within and across organizations and sectors.
- Attendees felt a strong sense of a unified, **statewide nonprofit presence**.



Participant Profile

75% of survey respondents are Leadership Staff

30% of survey respondents have budgets of \$1-5 Million

25% of survey respondents have 10-19 paid employees

- 342 / 796 Summit participants responded to survey, a 45% response rate.
- Strong participation from all regions of SC
- Nearly **90%** in 35-54 age group
- 75% identify as women
- 33% identify as Black or African American
