# PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

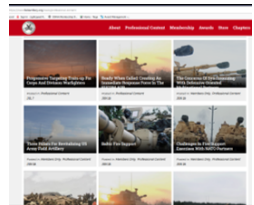
## FA JOURNAL

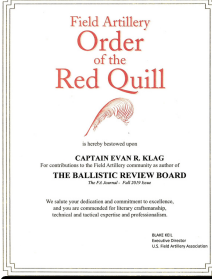


# WRITING AWARDS
