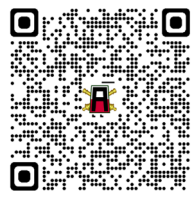

## **Vision**

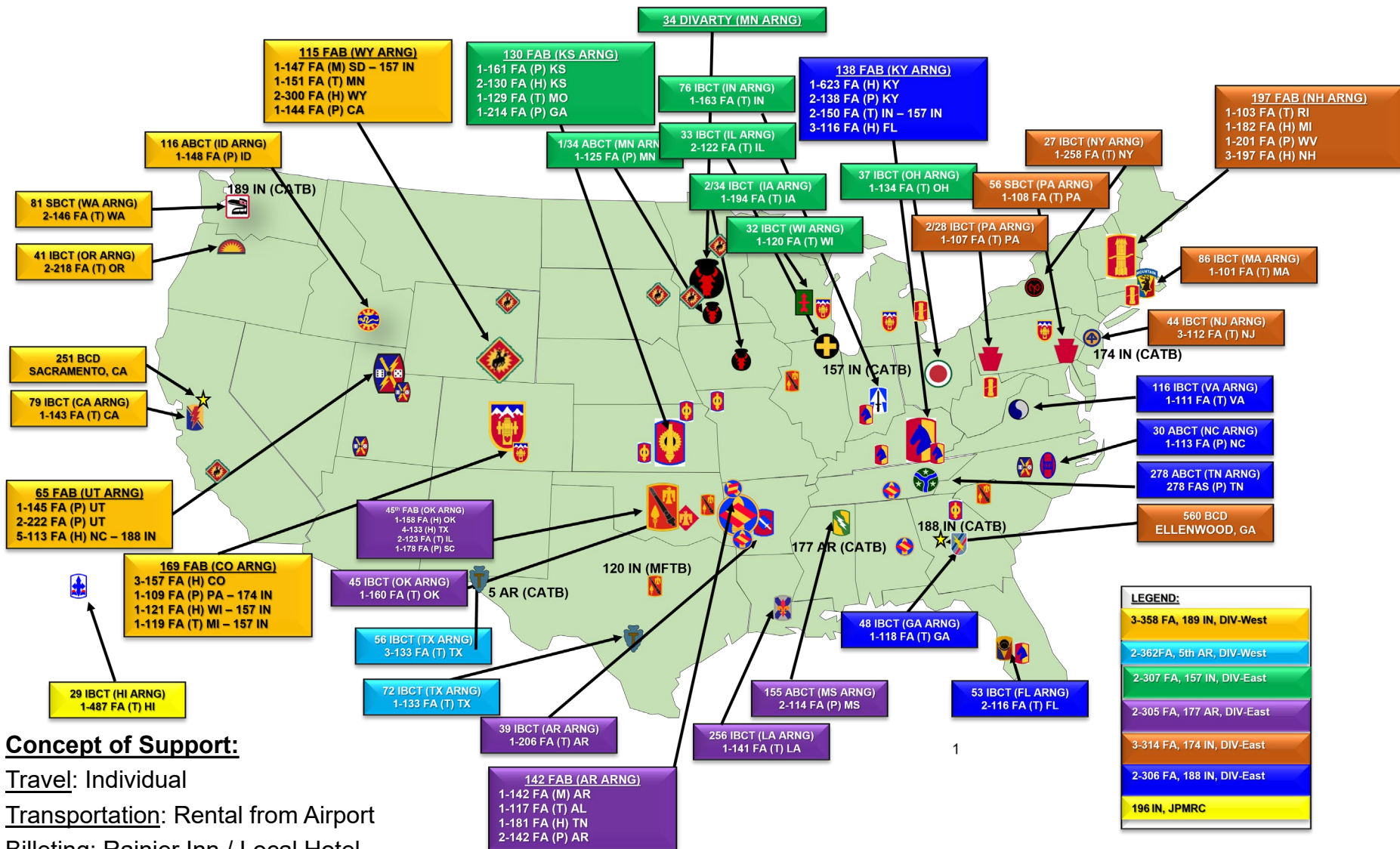
The First Army Redleg Symposium provides a forum for shared understanding and increases fellowship and collaboration amongst our Artillery Partners
