

# How to Navigate a High-Stress Career and Relationships

Dr. Jeanette McMurtrie is not your typical aviation expert. With a unique blend of experience in both the airline industry as a captain and with a doctorate in relationship psychology, Jeanette offers unparalleled insights into the challenges faced by aviation professionals, particularly pilots, and their relationships. Her teachings are built on a simple but effective rule: communicate in a way that resolves conflict without escalating it, ensuring that both partners in a relationship work together toward a common goal.

Dr. McMurtrie's work is invaluable not only for pilots but for anyone navigating a high-stress career and relationships. Her ability to bridge the worlds of aviation and relationship psychology makes her a truly unique voice in the field. 
