Special consideration is given to individuals or groups who have helped other women be successful in aviation or opened doors of opportunity for other women. Candidates can be living or deceased. A judging committee will review all applications and will make final selections based on how the nominee's contributions met the criteria of record setting or pioneering efforts. A maximum of three candidates will be inducted at the 37th Annual Women in Aviation International Conference in Grapevine, Texas, during the Pioneer Hall of Fame Ceremony on Friday, March 20, 2026.
