Applications for the Women in Leadership: A Program for Emerging Leaders course, a three-day, on-campus professional development program hosted by WAI at Harvard University's Division of Continuing Education in Cambridge, Massachusetts will be offered for the second year! The intensive, three-day program will be held May 7-9, 2024, with a follow-up virtual leadership coaching session to be scheduled in June 2024.

The application deadline is December 31, 2023, by 11:59 p.m. EST. Rising women leaders in the aviation and aerospace industry are encouraged to apply to this course to further their career goals and leadership skills.
