WAI To Launch Emerging Leaders Professional Development Program

WAI and Harvard University Division of Continuing Education are working together to launch the Emerging Leaders Professional Development Program for our members. This members who have 5-10 years of experience and are interested in furthering their careers and leadership roles in the aviation and aerospace industry.

With generous funding from the Conrad N. Hilton Foundation, 30 women will be chosen to receive funding support that will include program fees, hotel, meals, and a stipend for airfare. Applicants will spend two days on Harvard University's campus Wednesday, May 3 through Thursday, May 4, 2023, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. each day, with a follow-up virtual leadership coaching session to be held on May 16, 2023.



The Harvard University campus is in Cambridge, Massachusetts. Applications for this new Emerging Leaders Professional Development Program are <u>available</u> <u>online</u> and must be submitted by March 15, 2023. Attendees will be notified of their acceptance on April 1, 2023.
