## Good Luck to our Emerging Leaders Program Attendees!



Since the very first Women in Aviation International Girls in Aviation Day in 2015, the annual WAI event has grown every year since its first gathering of 32 events and 3,200 participants. WAI Chapters and Corporate members are encouraged to use all the available WAI resources to help you organize an awesome learning experience for girls, ages 8-18.

The official date for the 9th Annual Girls in Aviation Day is Saturday, September 23, 2023. Some events will take place before or after depending on the schedules of your local community.
