Updates From WAI Membership Team

At the beginning of 2025, WAI moved to a more environmentally sustainable distribution plan and frequency for the *Aviation for Women (AFW)* and *Aviation for Girls (AFG)* magazines delivering each issue (*AFW* quarterly, *AFG* annually) digitally by default to Student and Individual members. If Individual or Student members would like to receive a printed copy of *AFW*, we ask that you "opt-in" for the printed version, which will be delivered at no additional charge until your next renewal date. At your next renewal date, if individual members wish to receive a printed issue of *AFW*, you'll see a \$20 fee for this membership add-on.

In 2025, WAI is also adding the ability to send communications such as membership renewal reminders, event notifications, and program information via SMS/text message inside the U.S. and Canada.
