- Omni Air is a leading provider of passenger airlift services to the US Department of Defense via the CRAF program, and a worldwide provider of full-service passenger charter and ACMI services
  - Pilot Requirements:
    - Unrestricted ATP or ATP/CTP course completed
    - 1,500 hours Total Time
    - 500 hours Fixed Wing PIC
    - 23 Years Old
  - Pilots are home based; Positive Space tickets provided
    - Most direct routing is standard. Direct flights before connections.
    - International deadhead over 3 hours booked in business class
    - Business or First-class travel. Pilots may opt for payment stipend instead of upgraded seating
    - Keep all airline and many hotel reward points
  - Pilots issued company credit card
  - Pilots use Company provided transportation or Company Uber account when required
  - Pilots use a line bidding system:
    - Lines consist of days of known scheduled flying and/or scheduled reserve days.
    - Schedules are 16 days with 1 day designated as override days that if actually used go above monthly guarantee
  - Company reimburses up to \$350 for FAA medical
  - Uniform allowance with roll-over balance every year
  - Pilots are issued KCM/CASS access
  - New-Hire pay while in training \$1,000 per week plus Domestic per diem while in Training
    - Training conducted at Omni Training Center in Dallas, TX
    - Training approximately 6-8 weeks long
  - First Year Pay starts upon completion of PC
    - First Year Pay is: \$128.36/hr
    - 64 hour Guarantee each month (12 pay periods a year)
    - Domestic Per-Diem: \$2.30/hr
    - International Per-Diem: \$3.20/hr
