



Honestly, I was just doing my job. I wanted to be a cop who flew helicopters, and I just happened to be the first.

2) Who is your inspiration?

My father introduced me to aviation, but my grandmother was my inspiration. She was a woman beyond her time. She continued her education and worked during a time when many women didn;t, and had a family later in life when many women did it younger. When my grandfather passed away at a young age and left my grandmother with four children, she had the motivation and financial knowledge to manage her family all by herself. I miss her dearly, and know when she looks down on me she is proud of what I accomplished.
